



Darkhorse Wrestling Club 2017 Invitational Tournament

- DATE:** Sunday, March 5, 2017
- TIMES:** **Wrestling begins at 9:00 a.m. for ALL age groups.** Tot – Midget will wrestle in the Main Gym; Novice – Elite will wrestle in the adjacent Auxiliary Gym. **All scratches must be made with the Head Paired by 8:15 a.m.** Coaches/Officials meeting @ 8:15 a.m. Table Workers meeting at 8:15 a.m. Pairers should arrive by 7:45 a.m.
- LOCATION:** Billings Senior High School, 425 Grand Ave., Billings, MT; Please park and enter on the north side of the building.
- WEIGH-INS:** Honor weigh-ins to be completed Thursday evening, Mar. 2nd. No Sunday weigh-ins.
- REGISTRATION:** We will be running this tournament on the Track Wrestling system, accessible by logging on to www.trackwrestling.com. Registration must be completed on this site by selecting “Browse,” then “Tournaments.” Then click “Search” and input “Darkhorse Invitational.” Finally, click “Pre-Register” and navigate through the registration process. **Registrations must be complete by 8:00 A.M. on Friday, Mar. 3rd.** After that, they will be closed. - REQUIREMENTS:** Each club will be required to provide 1 adult referee, 1 pairer, and 2 table workers. Fines will be assessed if not provided. Pairers, please contact Amanda Cortez prior to the tournament. You will need to bring a laptop or iPad to the tournament to work a table.
- ENTRY FEE:** \$7 per wrestler – Payable directly through registration at www.trackwrestling.com.
- ADMISSIONS:** Adults: \$6 Students: \$4 Kids 5 & Under: Free
- AWARDS:** Medals 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place; Ribbons 4th, 5th, & 6th place; Team trophies: Sm., Med., Large
- CONCESSIONS:** Full concessions will be available all day. No coolers please.
- SANCTION:** This event is licensed by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U.S., Inc. All participants must have a current AAU Membership. AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event. AAU **Youth** Athlete membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connection. **Be Prepared: Adult and Non-Athlete memberships are no longer instant and cannot be applied for at event.
