The 6th Annual AAU Detroit Summer Basketball League will begin league play on Monday, July 14, 2014. If you're looking for organization, competitive games, age appropriate age groups, seasoned referees and great facilities, then year six of the D-League is a must.

The summer league is a weekday league only and is done over most of the school dead periods. Boys play on Monday evenings and the Girls play on Tuesday evenings. The league last a total of 4-weeks and on the final week teams will play twice, to wrap-up the league-(Boys Monday & Wednesday/Girls Tuesday & Thursday).

Last season over **350 teams competed in the AAU D-Leagues** and over 92 teams in the last year's Summer basketball league. Midwest Athletics will open 10 more spots for the Summer session for 2014. The Summer D-League will be **open to the first 102 teams** to register.
