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ORDER OF EVENTS

ALL RUNNING EVENTS ARE TIMED FINALS. Running Events will be on a rolling schedule. Athletes must listen to announcements and check in at the designated check-in area for their event at least 30 minutes early. Any athlete who does not check in before their scheduled heat will not compete in the event.

 100 m Hurdles – SYG, YG, SYB, YB, IG, YW
 110 m Hurdles – IB, YM
 4x800 m Relay – Age groups will be combined
 100 m Dash – All age groups, starting with PG
 400 m Dash – All age groups, starting with PG
 1500 m Run – Age groups will be combined by gender
 200 m Hurdles – SYG, YG, SYB, YB
 400 m Hurdles – IG, YW, IB, YM
 4x100 m Relay – Age groups may be combined by gender
 800 m Run – Age groups will be combined by gender
 200 m Dash – All age groups, starting with PG
 4x400 m Relay – Age groups may be combined by gender

FIELD EVENTS will follow the time schedule below, but may start up to 30 minutes early for any age grouping. Athletes must listen to announcements for Field Event calls. All athletes must report before their designated flight starts to compete, and any athlete who is also competing in a running event will be released ONLY by the Field Event Official at the appropriate time, and must report back within 10 minutes of the completion of their running event. Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put, Discus and Javelin will be contested with four jumps or throws. NO finals in field events.

 ** Competitors should bring their own implements to be used at this Meet.

All athletes who "COMPETE" in a District Meet are eligible to compete at any National Qualifiers Meet, as long as they receive a legal time/jump/throw. Relay teams must have competed at the District Level to be eligible to enter a team in a specific relay at a National Qualifiers Meet, but a team member who did not compete at the District Level may still register as a member of a qualified relay team. All relay member guidelines will be enforced as stated in the AAU Athletics Handbook. Athletes competing in the Multi-Events, Steeplechase and Pole Vault are "EXEMPT" from previously competing in a District Meet to be eligible to compete at a National Qualifiers Meet. AAU Track & Field athletes and clubs are only eligible to compete in ONE (1) National Qualifiers Meet.
