The Indian River Golf Foundation Players Club is pleased to host the **2014 AAU Florida Junior Golf Championship** to be held at Sandridge Golf Club – Vero Beach, FL. The AAU Florida Junior Golf Championship is a premier competitive and developmental golf experience serving junior golfers. The host AAU Club, IRGF Players Club, is conducting this open tournament for individuals to compete in four age groups. The starting field will be limited to 80 players. Spots may be open to additional players based upon availability. The 2014 AAU Florida Junior Golf Championship is scheduled for **Saturday & Sunday, June 7th & 8th** hosted by **Sandridge PGA Director of Golf Bela Nagy, Roger Van Dyke, President – Indian River Golf Foundation and Anthony Donadio, IRGF Program Director.**

Acceptance of entries for the 2014 AAU Florida Junior Golf Championship are based upon AAU membership, player performance in local junior golf tournaments and recognized regional, state and national golf tournaments/tours. **Deadline for entry – June 4, 2014.** In the event of oversubscription, the starting field will be determined by a player ranking system. Applications received after the deadline for entry will be based upon availability.

Players will play in 18 and 9 holes divisions each day.... **36 holes (two days) Individual Stroke Play and 18 holes (two days) Individual Stroke Play** formats of play. Tournament awards will be issued to the top individuals in each age group during an Awards Luncheon following play on Day 2.

All play will be Saturday afternoon (tee times) and Sunday morning (shotgun start) by age group.

One key ingredient of the 2014 AAU Florida Junior Golf Championship is **affordability** with a tournament fee set at \$80 per player for 36 hole players and \$60 for 18 hole players. Scholarships available. Each player will receive a **custom bag tag**. **Awards will be presented** upon completion of all play.

The **IRGF Players Club** has established the Florida AAU Junior Golf Championship as a prominent junior event to be staged over 36 holes every June. A limited number will participate with the following divisions:

18 Hole - Boys & Girls Age Groups	16 - 18	13 - 15
9 Hole - Boys & Girls Age Groups	10 - 12	9 & Under

Note: 16 - 18 and 13 - 15 Boys & Girls will play their SAME respective tees.

Overall Boys & Girls Champions will come out of the 16 - 18 or 13 - 15 Divisions.

Yardages for tee marker setting will be age appropriate.

Overall Winner in the Boys Division and the Girls Division will receive complimentary entry into the 2014 AAU National Junior Golf Championship in Tennessee.

Winners of 16 - 18 & 13 - 15 receive exemptions for Florida Junior Tour events.

To register.....complete the online 2014 AAU Florida Junior Golf Championship Application for Entry at www.irgf.org REGISTRATION. **2014 AAU membership is required to participate in this event.** Players not AAU registered may do so by applying online at AAU - cost of \$16 per person per year (September 1st – August 31st). The benefits include up to \$50,000 Accidental Medical Insurance during the competition.
