<u>ENTRY FEE:</u>	<b>\$225.00</b> per team (received no later than the entry deadline date) to enter the 2015 division for which your team qualifies. Teams who wish to also play in an older division may take advantage of a reduced entry fee of \$175.00 per team (2 <sup>nd</sup> & 3 <sup>rd</sup> entries only).Teams may pay with a <b>Cashier's Check</b> or <b>Money Order</b> made payable to: <b>Kanawha Girls Basketball Club</b> , PO Box 5214, Charleston, WV 25361-5214. <b>No Personal Checks</b> will be accepted. 	<b>2)</b> Penalty for breaking the 15-point rule mentioned above is a warning for the first offense and an administrative technical foul for the second offense. If the rule is broken a third time, a technical foul goes to the coach.
<u>EQUIPMENT:</u>	<ol> <li>The Rawlings 28.5" circumference composite basketball shall be the official basketball for all AAU District Championship Tournaments except for the 3rd Grade Division.</li> <li>AAU 3rd grade District Tournaments will use the Rawlings 27.5" basketball. The foul line for these tournaments will be moved to 12'.</li> <li>30 second shot clocks will be used ONLY in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade, 9<sup>th</sup> grade and 10<sup>th</sup> Grade District Championship Tournaments.</li> </ol>
<u>UNIFORMS:</u>	<ol> <li>Each team participating in any AAU Tournament must have two (2) different color team jerseys (shirts). One of the jerseys must be light.</li> <li>Team shirts shall be of the same solid color front and back. A player's shirt designed to be worn inside the game pants shall be tucked inside the game pants throughout the game.</li> <li>An undershirt is considered to be part of the shirt and must be a color similar to the shirt. Logos, decorations, trim, commemorative patches, lettering and numbering are not allowed on an undershirt.</li> <li>No more than two identifying names or abbreviations of the names may be placed on either, or on both, the front and back of the shirt. The name(s) must be placed so that the following can take place.         <ul> <li>Players' jerseys must have numbers on both the front and back. (Numbers can be from 00 to 99.) Minimum size of numbers shall be 2" on the front and 4" on the back.</li> <li>Placement must be such that the number(s) is clearly visible.</li> <li>Tights that extend below the game pants must be similar in color to the game pants.</li> </ul> </li> <li>The HOME team shall sit to the official scorer's right facing the table. A team may have on its bench only eligible players in uniform and four non-players. Violation of this rule shall result in a two shot technical foul. The violator will be removed from the bench. At least one person age 18 or older must be on the bench at all times.</li> </ol>
<u>AWARDS:</u>	For each age division, AAU District Championship medals will be awarded to the first, second, third and fourth place teams. All-Tournament awards will be presented in each age division.
<u>PROTEST PROCEDURES:</u>	The WV District Girls Basketball Eligibility Committee shall serve as the Protest Committee. Protests must be made in writing within two (2) hours of the completion of the game being protested. A fee of \$100.00 cash (refunded if protest is upheld) must accompany the protest. Protests must come from a non-athlete member listed on the official online roster. All decisions of the Protest Committee shall be final.
<u>FORFEITS:</u>	Forfeits disrupt a tournament, and cause ill feelings among tournament sponsors, players, coaches, and fans. Teams, which enter a sanctioned AAU event, are expected to compete in all scheduled games. There will be a \$50.00 forfeit fee charged for each game forfeited in the District Championships. There will be no exceptions. The team who forfeits will not be allowed to participate in any further competition until the \$50.00 fee has been paid.
